A Cheat Sheet for the Stock Selection Guide

Besides the multitude of other useful information, the BetterInvesting website has available for downloading **Guidelines for Beginners**. This is a reference sheet that "presents basic guidelines for beginners when completing your own Stock Selection Guide."

It is set up in a logical sequence to work through an SSG. The first page covers **Step 1: Perform a Quality Check on Your Selected Stock.**

The second page is **Step 2: Add Judgement to Complete your SSG.** The guide contains some **basic rules of thumb** to keep in mind while completing an SSG.

It's designed to help both novice and intermediate SSG users follow BetterInvesting Best Practices. If used consistently the guide can help develop "muscle memory" habits for doing SSGs, save time by quickly identifying poor candidates, and reinforce other SSG tools.

The guide can also be useful for clubs. It can be valuable helping new members learn to do SSGs but it can also help all the club members be in sync with the way they prepare SSGs.

Stock Picking Contest Update

Here's the status of the Stock Picking Contest. There was a little shuffling at the top of the list. Of note is the winning portfolio from last year. It wasn't entered in the contest this year but just for kicks it was listed with the other entrants using the same portfolio as last year and starting with \$100,000 like the rest. It is currently in first place again. This portfolio was 50% in technology stocks.

Each portfolio began at \$100,000. Two to ten securities could be chosen. You could enter a security if Yahoo could price it, no cryptocurrencies.
